Sub: Extension of period of temporary registration of Bus/Trucks for body building-clarification thereof.

Sir,


It has been brought to the notice of undersigned that some of the RTOs are demanding tax and penalty from the date of expiry of temporary registration of chassis which was detained at workshop for construction of body.

In this context your attention is drawn to proviso to Section 43 (2) of M.V. Act, 1988 which provides that:-

“Provided that where a motor vehicle so registered is a chassis to which a body has not been attached and the same is detained in a workshop beyond the said period of one month for being fitted with a body or any unforeseen circumstances beyond the control of the owner, the period may, on payment of such fees, if any, as may be prescribed, be extended by such further period or periods as the registering authority or other prescribed authority, as the case may be, may allow.”

You are therefore, requested to extend the period of validity of temporary registration on payment of fees for such further period, as the case may be, till the date of issue of certificate by the body builder in Part – II of Form – 22-A of CMV Rules, 1989 without charging tax and penalty under serial 3, 4 and 4B of Schedule – I of OMVT Act, 1975.
